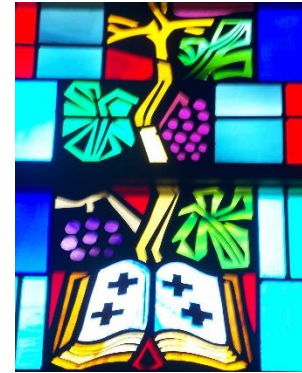

## About the Instructor

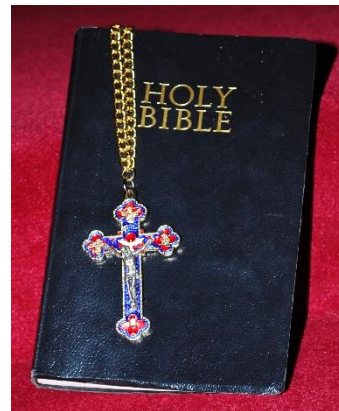
